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



Women in Leadership

Misunderstood

- How many times have strong women been labeled as Jezebels because God has blessed them with leadership qualities? Or being accused that we are trying to usurp a man's' authority.
- Being a woman called to leadership is a much tougher position then when a man is in a leadership position. We need to keep our lives and homes in balance and show ourselves to truly be women who only want to serve God.

Not Being Taken Seriously

- I don't know how many times I have taught on a topic only to hear someone in our Congregation, extol the teaching of a male counterpart and saying the same thing I just taught on as if they never heard it before. LOL
- Also, the critics my husband Minister Scott has endured from other men because I am the Teacher (I am an Ordained Rabbi, taught by Messianic Jewish Rabbis), and He is the Evangelist. However, We know that we are one in Messiah each fulfilling what The Almighty Father has called us to do as a Team.

The Fine Line We Walk

- We need to constantly be on guard so that pride does not get a hold of us or bitterness. We need to keep our spiritual lives in order and our homes. We need to make sure that we never bring a reproach on the Name of God because of actions that are not considered proper for a woman.
- We must avoid self-pity when we experience all of the above realizing that the only approval, we need to be concerned about is God's.

Keeping our Femineity in a Man's World

- As women we have a unique perspective, we have been blessed with deeper spiritual incite and discernment and the heart of a mother.
- We do not have to act like a man in order to be accepted. If we are anointed and speak forth the truth, then those who have discerning hearts will take heed to our words and teaching.

• Rev. Martha Looper says the following in her article "What Women Can Be and Do is Revealed by God's Call on the life of Biblical Women". "In the Hebrew Scriptures, there is not the slightest bent that God ever discriminated against women. Indeed, the Holy Scriptures themselves are the most powerful witness to God's opportunities and giving nature and supernatural empowerment to women for a virtual unending and limitless range of ministries and works of service to God and man." She goes on to say "The truth is that gender bias in the Church has always been rooted in the Philosophy of the Greco-Roman World, not in Holy Scripture or in the Jewish tradition.

- God is consistent throughout the Tenach and Brit HaDasha in His dealing with women. Far from being less than men, they are equal with men;
 - In Creation, they are equal
 - In Salvation, they are equal
 - In Gods gifts and graces, they are equal
- There is also an equality in proclamation so that all women dedicated to God and his service can be used where needed in ministry, administration, or leadership.
- However, women's greatest arena of ministry can and should be their own home and children." It is in the homes of these "Eishet Chayel"/ Women of Valor that future Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Rabbis and Teachers and workers of the ministry of Yeshua Ha Mashiach/Jesus the Messiah are being raised to reach the lost for the Kingdom of God.

Dr. Howard Morgan in his article "Women in Ministry, anointed for Service, Robbed • of Opportunity" says the following. "The position of women in ministry has for many centuries been troubling to much of the Church. However, as we go back to our Jewish Roots, we discover that the true faith of Abraham provides both anointing and opportunity for women to fulfill their callings in the Kingdom of God. As the church departed from her Jewish Roots, she lost her understanding of the Kingdom of God and adopted the pagan understanding of "gentile authority" which Yeshua/Jesus warned us against and prohibited His disciples from emulating. This kind of authority by its nature is oppressive and repressive. It seeks to keep in power and authority those who by their military strength, political standing, or financial resources have acquired dominant position in society. The Kingdom of God, as it is revealed in the Jewish Scriptures, is built, upon an entirely different structure. The greatest in the Kingdom of God are those who serve Matthew 23:11.3

Dr. John Garr of Restore Ministries says this in his article "The • Biblical Women, Lessons for Today's Church from its Hebraic Heritage" "After two millennia as a new era dawned, much of Israel had been influenced by Hellenisms misogyny so that women were often denied equal opportunity before God. Women's freedom to minister before God was gradually withdrawn in Second Temple Judaism. Though their material rights were protected by the edicts of Halahcha rendered by the sages, women found themselves more and more restricted to home and in increasingly subservient relationships to father and husband. The coming of Yeshua brought a reformation of restoration to the original intents of the Torah. Yeshua elevated women to spiritual equality with men, so that they could sit among the Talmudism (disciples) "at his feet" and be covered with the dust of their Rabbi and Lord."

- He goes on to say "Though some Christian Theologians of subsequent centuries have suggested that it is not fitting and proper that a woman should "carry the Word of God" He (God) arranged it so that one women carried The Word for nine months before anyone else saw Him! Then in another twist of irony, he also provided that the first evangelist to proclaim the good news of the resurrection was a woman, and a redeemed prostitute at that! Paul encapsulated the Messiahs position regarding women in Christian/Messianic service. "There is.... neither male nor female, for ye are all on in Messiah Yeshua/Christ Jesus.
- And if ye be Messiahs/Christ then are ye.... heirs according to the promise." Galatians 3:28. Men and Women share equal rights to inherit the promises, blessings, anointing's and appointments of Gods Kingdom. "lech l'cha" "Get up and go" and purpose in our hearts to leave Babylon's Gentile Traditions and go to Yerushalyim (Jerusalem) where there is freedom and equality for men and women in the biblical Hebraic Heritage of our faith

Know your Calling, Know Your Gifts

Spiritual Gifts Test – Varity of Ministries and Gifts (see Spiritual Gifts Test that was sent)

- Leadership—Leadership aids the body by leading and directing members to accomplish the goals and purposes of the church. Leadership motivates people to work together in unity toward common goals (Rom. 12:8).
- Administration—Persons with the gift of administration lead the body by steering others to remain on task. Administration enables the body to organize according to God-given purposes and long-term goals (1 Cor. 12:28).
- **Teaching**—Teaching is instructing members in the truths and doctrines of God's Word for the purposes of building up, unifying, and maturing the body (1 Cor. 12:28; Rom. 12:7; Eph. 4:11).
- Knowledge The gift of knowledge manifests itself in teaching and training in discipleship. It is the God-given ability to learn, know, and explain the precious truths of God's Word. A word of knowledge is a Spirit-revealed truth (1 Cor. 12:28).
- Wisdom—Wisdom is the gift that discerns the work of the Ruach HaKodesh in the body and applies His teachings and actions to the needs of the body (1 Cor. 12:28).
- **Prophecy**—The gift of prophecy is proclaiming the Word of God boldly. This builds up the body and leads to conviction of sin. Prophecy manifests itself in preaching and teaching (1Cor. 12:10; Rom. 12:6).

Know your Calling, Know Your Gifts

Spiritual Gifts Test – Varity of Ministries and Gifts

- **Discernment**—Discernment aids the body by recognizing the true intentions of those within or related to the body. Discernment tests the message and actions of others for the protection and well-being of the body (1 Cor. 12:10).
- **Exhortation**—Possessors of this gift encourage members to be involved in and enthusiastic about the work of the Lord. Members with this gift are good counselors and motivate others to service. Exhortation exhibits itself in preaching, teaching, and ministry (Rom. 12:8).
- **Shepherding**—The gift of shepherding is manifested in persons who look out for the spiritual welfare of others. Although pastors, like shepherds, do care for members of the Community of Messiah, this gift is not limited to a pastor or staff member (Eph. 4:11).
- **Faith**—Faith trusts God to work beyond the human capabilities of the people. Believers with this gift encourage others to trust in God in the face of apparently insurmountable odds (1 Cor. 12:9).
- **Evangelism** —God gifts his church with evangelists to lead others to Messiah effectively and enthusiastically. This gift builds up the body by adding new members to its fellowship (Eph. 4:11).

Know your Calling, Know Your Gifts

Spiritual Gifts Test – Varity of Ministries and Gifts

- Apostleship—The Community of Messiah sends apostles from the body to plant Community of Believers or be missionaries. Apostles motivate the body to look beyond its walls in order to carry out the Great Commission (1 Cor. 12:28; Eph. 4:11).
- Service/Helps—Those with the gift of service/helps recognize practical needs in the body and joyfully give assistance to meeting those needs. Believers with this gift do not mind working behind the scenes (1 Cor. 12:28; Rom. 12:7).
- Mercy—Cheerful acts of compassion characterize those with the gift of mercy. Persons with this gift aid the body by empathizing with hurting members. They keep the body healthy and unified by keeping others aware of the needs within the Community of Messiah (Rom. 12:8).
- **Giving**—Members with the gift of giving give freely and joyfully to the work and mission of the body. Cheerfulness and liberality are characteristics of individuals with this gift (Rom. 12:8).
- Hospitality—Those with this gift have the ability to make visitors, guests, and strangers feel at ease. They often use their home to entertain guests. Persons with this gift integrate new members into the body (1 Pet. 4:9).

God has gifted you with an expression of His Ruach HaKodesh to support His vision and mission of the Community of Messiah. It is a worldwide vision to reach all people with the gospel of Messiah. As a servant leader, God desires that you know how He has gifted you. This will lead you to where He would have you serve as part of His vision and mission for the Community of Messiah.



6 Steps to Be an Excellent Women of Adonai in Ministry, In Messiah Yeshua.

• Step No. 1: Be Dedicated to Excellence in Ministry

You are called to ministry. Whether God has called you to be a pastor or a first-rate engineer, if you are a born-again Christian, God has a purpose for your life that will further the kingdom of God. He strategically places His people all over the world—not only in pulpits and on mission fields, but in homes, offices, schools and the marketplace.

But to succeed in ministry, it isn't as simple as heeding the call. To be effective and fulfill God's purpose for your ministry, you need to get on the road to excellence, run the race, and "obtain the prize."

The ministry of Jesus was one of excellence, and one that laid the foundation for success. Once you know your calling, to follow Jesus' example, you must pursue excellence in every aspect of your life and ministry.

What Is Excellence?

The root of the word *excellent* is *excel*, which means "to rise to the highest place or to pass in accomplishments or achievement, to be distinguishable by superiority." Excellence does everything with the highest quality and integrity. It is never subpar or mediocre in any way. Excellence stands above the rest.

In ministry, a spirit of excellence is a desire to reach *toward* The Almighty YHVH Elohim rather than get something *from* YHVH Elohim. That's why a ministry of excellence will never promote itself or force success. It allows the gospel to do the promoting.

- Step No. 1: Be Dedicated to Excellence in Ministry
- A ministry of excellence is a ministry that does not plan to fail. Whatever you have been called to—pastor, apostle, prophet, evangelist, teacher or any other role in the Body of Messiah, the Lord will not revoke the assignment given to you (Romans 11:29), so you are responsible for how you handle your calling. To do that, you must be dedicated to excellence in every area of your ministry and dedicated to success.
- When you stand before the Judgment Seat of Messiah, it will be in the light of your calling—not what you did, not what you meant to do or wished you had done, but what Adonai said you were appointed to do. This applies not only to the fivefold ministry but to every member of Messiah's Body.

Step No. 2: Have Singleness of Purpose

- What does it mean to have singleness of purpose? It means to be single-minded and driven in one direction. If you drive a car without a single destination in mind, you'll be zigzagging and driving in circles. You won't get anywhere! But when you have singleness of purpose, everything you do will drive you in that one direction.
- What is your single purpose as a minister of Adonai? <u>To meet the needs of people.</u> Many
 individuals and ministries often lose sight of this purpose. They get distracted with the
 number of people responding to them, the budget, projects or publicity. They don't mean to,
 but sooner or later, they forget their purpose—<u>to meet the needs of people.</u>
- We find in James 1:6-8 why single-mindedness is so important: "He who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways" (NKJV).

- Step No. 3: Follow the Leadership of the Holy Spirit/Ruach HaKodesh
- The path to excellence in life and in ministry is always the same—follow the leadership of the Holy Spirit/Ruach HaKodesh. Let's face it, your mind likes to do a lot of its own planning, but if you lean on your own understanding, it's only a matter of time before you fall flat. God has called you to a particular ministry, and He fully intends to lead you into excellence, success and a life beyond what you could ever imagine on your own.
- That's why He has given you the Holy Spirit—to guide you, instruct you and keep you on the
 path to excellence. A person who desires a ministry of excellence should pray in tongues at
 least an hour a day, and particularly before you preach or minister. Then, learn to follow the
 leadership of the Holy Spirit within you. You will find yourself equipped with the answer to any
 challenge that comes your way.

• Step No. 4: Strip Away the Things of the World

- Excellence in ministry requires an excellent spirt in every area. This includes the conduct of those who work with you in ministry, as well as the operations of your place of ministry. For example, if your ministry is in your home, determine to have a home that is run with excellence. This means your home will be neat and clean, it will run in an organized way, and your children will be well-behaved. More importantly, you must first determine to have excellence in your own conduct.
- The same is true if you are a pastor of a Kahilah/Congregation. Every part of your Kahilah should operate with excellence. But it isn't right to demand excellence from your staff or congregation if you don't demand excellence in your own conduct. If your ministry is in a secular field, the same is true as well. Strive for excellence—expect excellence from your staff, in the dealings of your business, and in your own conduct. You can't live a sloppy life and have an excellent ministry.

• Step No. 5: Look to the Word of God Day and Night

- We already know that faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God (Romans 10:17, NKJV). So, to achieve excellence in ministry, look to the Word of God day and night. It will guide you and keep you on the road to excellence. It will keep you from turning to the right or the left or using worldly wisdom to determine the path of your ministry.
- Proverbs 4:20-22 says, "My child, pay attention to what I say. Listen carefully to my words. Don't lose sight of them. Let them penetrate deep into your heart, for they bring life to those who find them, and healing to their whole body." The Word is life and healing, and it stands for excellence in all things. Know who you are "In Messiah Yeshua".
- Exalt the Word in your life and ministry. Let it do the work. If there is ever a problem, apply God's wisdom to it. Speak and act only on the Word. If you exalt the Word, people will be delivered.
- In any area of ministry, if there is ever any doubt about which direction you should be headed, look toward the Word to direct you. Put the Word first. If you do this, everything else will take care of itself.

- Step No. 6: Spend Time Fasting
- To keep in tune with the Holy Spirit/Ruach HaKodesh in your ministry, spend time fasting. The spiritual practice of
 fasting will help you hear from God and keep your flesh in line. Remember—fasting doesn't push God into action, it helps
 you hear from God. He is always talking to us, but sometimes our "receiver" isn't working as it should. Fasting is a tool
 that puts us in position to be more spiritually aware and "tuned in" to God. Anyone who desires an excellent ministry
 continually seeks Adonai for direction. A fast will put you in the position to hear from God to receive guidance for a
 specific situation. Remember to keep your fast private and follow Yeshua's guidelines (<u>Matthew 6:16-18</u>). Hypocritical
 piety will defeat the purpose of a fast. If you publicize your spirituality, you will exchange the reward from God for a
 reward from men.

(Mat 6:5 TLV) "When you pray, do not be like the hypocrites; for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the street corners, so that they may be seen by others. Amen, I tell you, they have their reward in full!

- (Mat 6:6 TLV) But you, when you pray, go into your inner room; and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in secret. And your Father, who sees in secret, shall reward you.
- (Mat 6:16 TLV) "And whenever you fast, do not become sad-faced like the hypocrites, for they neglect their faces to make their fasting evident to men. Amen, I tell you, they have their reward in full!
- (Mat 6:17 TLV) But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face,
- (Mat 6:18 TLV) so that your fasting won't be evident to men, but to your Father who is in secret. And your Father, who sees in secret, will reward you.
- Spend time fasting and submitting your ministry to the leading of the Lord. This will help ensure excellence in your ministry every step of the way.

- Scriptures...
- (Ezr 7:9 TLV) He began his aliyah from Babylon on the first day of the first month and entered Jerusalem on the first day of the fifth month, because the good hand of his God was upon him.
- (Ezr 7:10 TLV) For Ezra had set his heart to seek the Torah of Adonai, to observe and to teach its statues and ordinances in Israel.
- (2Ti 2:15 TLV) Make every effort to present yourself before God as tried and true, as an unashamed worker cutting a straight path with the word of truth.
- (2Ti 2:16 TLV) But avoid godless chatter, for it will lead to further ungodliness
- (Rom 11:29 TLV) for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

- Scriptures...
- (Php 3:12 TLV) Not that I have already obtained this or been perfected, but I press on if only I might take hold of that for which Messiah Yeshua took hold of me.
- (Php 3:13 TLV) Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself as having taken hold of this. But this one thing I do: forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead,
- (Php 3:14 TLV) I press on toward the goal for the reward of the upward calling of God in Messiah Yeshua.
- (Php 3:15 TLV) Therefore let all who are mature have this attitude; and if you have a different attitude in anything, this also God will reveal to you.

- Scriptures...
- (2Pe 1:3 TLV) His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and virtue.
- (2Pe 1:4 TLV) Through these things He has given us His precious and magnificent promises, so that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature, since you have escaped the corruption that evil desires have brought into the world.
- (2Pe 1:5 TLV) Now for this very reason, making every effort, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue, knowledge;
- (2Pe 1:6 TLV) and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, patience; and to patience, godliness;
- (2Pe 1:7 TLV) and to godliness, brotherly love; and to brotherly love, love.
- (2Pe 1:8 TLV) For if these qualities are in you and increasing, they keep you from becoming idle and unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Yeshua the Messiah.
- (2Pe 1:9 TLV) But anyone who lacks these qualities is blind—nearsighted because he has forgotten his cleansing from past sins.
- (2Pe 1:10 TLV) Therefore, brothers and sisters, make all the more effort to make your calling and election certain—for if you keep doing these things, you will never stumble.

- Scriptures...
- (Gal 5:22 TLV) But the fruit of the Ruach is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- (Gal 5:23 TLV) gentleness, and self-control—against such things there is no law.
- (Gal 5:24 TLV) Now those who belong to Messiah have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.
- (Gal 5:25 TLV) If we live by the Ruach, let us also walk by the Ruach.
- (Gal 5:26 TLV) Let us not become conceited—provoking one another, envying one another.

Accountability and Submission to His Will.

- (Eph 4:11 TLV) He Himself gave some to be emissaries, some as prophets, some as proclaimers of the Good News, and some as shepherds and teachers—
- (Eph 4:12 TLV) to equip the kedoshim for the work of service, for building up the body of Messiah.
- (Eph 4:13 TLV) This will continue until we all come to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of Ben-Elohim—to mature adulthood, to the measure of the stature of Messiah's fullness.
- (Eph 4:14 TLV) <u>As a result, we are no longer to be like children, tossed around by the waves</u> and blown all over by every wind of teaching, by the trickery of men with cunning in deceitful <u>scheming</u>.
- (Eph 4:15 TLV) Instead, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all ways into Messiah, who is the Head.
- (Eph 4:16 TLV) From Him the whole body is fitted and held together by every supporting ligament. <u>The proper working of each individual part produces the body's growth</u>, for building itself up in <u>love</u>.

Calling and Confirmations

- As you wait upon your calling and prepare yourself, The Father will bring confirmations to you via the Ruach HaKodesh. Just trust Him that He will confirm what He has called you to do.
