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# Healing – Our Brit/Covenant Of Blessing Rabbi Deborah Brandt Deborah's Messianic Ministries Beit Midrash Tefillah Hallel Synagogue

As Pastors/Rabbis of a Synagogue our heart is to see God's people walk in the fullness of His blessings. One of those blessings is that of health and healing. It is a promise to Israel in both the Tenach and Brit Hadasha.

One of the prayers we pray in the Shemon Esrie Amidah is for Healing.

Heal us, O L-rd, and we shall be healed, save us and we shall be saved, for Thou art our glory. Send complete healing for our every illness, for Thou, Divine King, art the faithful, merciful Physician. Blessed art Thou, L-rd, who heals the sick of His people Israel.

The promises of healing is found in the Tenach and in the Brit HaDasha Yeshua comfirms that it was Gods will that His people be made whole and He healed them! God is the same, yesterday, today and forever, He never changes and His will never changes because His will is His Word from B'resheet to Revelation.

It is important that you study these verses in context, but you will see as we study what the Word says about healing and that Yahweh is our healer. Health and restoration are always associated with God's blessings. Sickness and disease is not Yahweh's will for us health and restoration brings glory to God. Yeshua said that ha satan comes to steal, kill and destroy but He came that we may have life more abundantly. But don't take my word for it TAKE HIS WORD!

As we see what the Word says, let emunah/trust arise in your heart for healing, because you have been redeemed by the blood of Yeshua and healing belongs to the redeemed of Adonai, His people Israel.

Whenever God's people repented and walked in obedience to His Word healing came in every area of Israel's life. Sin, rebellion and disobedience opened the door for judgment and sickness to come in, but when Israel repented, healing and restoration returned.

If you are In Messiah then you have been grafted into the Covenants of Israel along with the blessings. Healing has always been a provision for His people Israel when they were obedient to walk in His ways and looked to Him for their healing and deliverance.

Gods word is true and this issue of healing must be settled in each persons heart individually. Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. Healing is in the Torah and is for His people Israel.

There are 4 areas of healing that can apply to our lives- Relational which starts first with your relationship with God if it has been broken because of sin and rebellion, repentance must come first, then when your relationship is right with God the healing process begins. If our relationship with God isn't right then our relationships with our brothers and sister in Messiah will not be right and will need healing as well. Also, when there is national repentance, then healing comes to a nation. When our relationships are in divine order then comes physical healing and emotional healing come as a result of repentance/Teshuvah and returning to His ways and His truth which is found in Messiah Yeshua follow as well.

# 14 Hebrew and Greek Words That Refer to Bodily Healing(1)

YHWH Rapha is one of the covenant names of Yahweh. Rapha means bodily healing.

1. The Hebrew word RAPHA is translated

1. cure - Jer. 33:6

Here Yahweh promises Judah and Israel that he will bring healing along with restoration.

The reason given for no- sickness upon the obedient was; God is the healer of His people, here He revealed Himself as YHWh-Ropheka, YHWH the Healer, or YHWH your Physician that heals you.

Yeshua is The Healer, The Deliverer, Our Salvation. When He walked among men, He healed all those who were sick and oppressed by the devil. He still walks among men, through the lives of His Chosen Ones, you and me, who call Him Master and Savior. Because He is in us, that same healing power flows from our lives to the lives of others, for He is the Great Physician who lives and abides forever.

<sup>12</sup> Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater *works* than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

<sup>13</sup> And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

We are to go forth and do what Yeshua did, heal the sick. He said 'the works that I do shall he do also". Who is He talking about? Those that believe in Him and have been grafted into Israel and He is the root. God still has a covenant of healing with Israel, if you belong to Messiah, then you belong to Israel and all the promises that were promised Israel belong to you because you have been grafted into the Olive Tree and the Covenant of Israel. All of Israel has a Brit /Covenant of Healing with the Holy one of Israel through Yeshua Ha Mashiach/Jesus the Messiah.

Messiah redeemed us from every curse that is listed under Deuteronomy 28: 15-68. Whatever is listed under the Curses you have been redeemed from through the shed blood of Messiah! Read the list and declare with boldness that the Living Torah carried your sicknesses and your infirmities and by His Stripes you have been healed.

If you are In Messiah, then you have been redeemed from the curse of sickness and disease. Let faith arise in your heart and rejoice for what Messiah has done for you. Do not let the enemy steal health from you any longer! You salvation came at a great price, The shed blood of Messiah, our Passover Lamb.

We have a better Covenant because it was paid for by the blood of Messiah. Now all the blessings found in His Word, the Torah, Prophets and writings and the Brit Hadasha, are all Yea and amen in Messiah. God made away for us to be accepted in His sight, He sent His only begotten Son to be our scapegoat. He carried our sins away on the execution stake/cross, so we can walk in the blessings of Abraham.

Sickness and disease are a part of the "All Things" that are under His feet. The Living Torah Yeshua. showed us what the Father's will was- "He healed the sick and ALL that were oppressed by the devil". Why? Because they had a covenant with God, and He came and confirmed that Covenant with Israel and said "Come Unto me ALL who are heavy laden and I will give you rest". That rest is for ALL who call upon Hashem. That rest is peace and soundness of mind and body. In His Kingdom, sickness and disease has no place. If it was not God's will to heal, then Yeshua was being disobedient to God and Torah by healing the sick and disobedience is sin. Since Yeshua was sinless, and walked in perfect obedience to the Torah, then health and wholeness is the will of God, and Yeshua said He came to do the Fathers will.

36 But I have greater witness than that of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me. John 5:36 (KJV)

If sickness and disease is a result of sin because of the first Adam, then how much more is healing and deliverance the result of salvation and forgiveness found in Messiah, the second and perfect Adam who came to "Take away the sins of the World."

Salvation, Healing and Deliverance bring Glory to Adonai, not sickness, disease and bondage.

Greek Word: therapeuo

**Usage Notes:** primarily signifies "to serve as a therapon, and attendant;" then, "to care for the sick, to treat, cure, heal" (Eng., "therapeutics"). It is chiefly used in Matthew and Luke, once in John (John 5:10), and, after the Acts, only Rev. 13:3, 12. 1[3]

This word "Therapeu" was used so much by Luke, because Luke was a Greek Physician( he was a proselyte to the Jewish faith and became part of the Messianic Community as one of Yeshua's Talmidim), so he used medical terms to describe Yeshua's healing ministry.

Yeshua ministered healing to "ALL" who were sick and oppressed. The only time He could not heal all, was in His own town because of their UNBELIEF in His Messianic Ministry, because Faith, based upon His Torah/Word and His Promises to us is the Key to receiving healing.

- <sup>1</sup> And he went out from thence, and came into his own country; and his disciples follow him.
- <sup>2</sup> And when the sabbath day was come, he began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing *him* were astonished, saying, From whence hath this *man* these things? and what wisdom *is* this which is given unto him, that even such mighty works are wrought by his hands?

They knew that as God's covenant people, healing belonged to them as part of their Covenant blessings, and to forbid Yeshua to

heal this daughter of Abraham, was to be deny what the Torah promised, healing to those who were the seed of Abraham. They were ashamed, because they knew what Yeshua said was based on the Covenant of Abraham and the Mosaic Covenant in the Torah, and they could not argue against the Word of God. Healing is in the Covenants and belongs to His Covenant people, it is a part of the blessings of Abraham and If you are a believer in Messiah that means that the Brit Birket/Covenant Blessing of healing belongs to YOU too!

This is the Promise made to God's people, to those who walk in obedience to His Torah/Word and have placed their faith and trust in the shed blood of Yeshua/Jesus. This promise finds its fulfillment in Messiah, because we are in Messiah/Christ these blessings apply to us as his Redeemed people, The Messianic Jewish believer and Messianic Israel believer (former Gentiles, who are Gentiles no longer because you have been Grafted Into the Olive Tree of Israel because of your faith in Messiah).

- "And the LORD shall make thee plenteous in goods, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy ground, in the land which the LORD sware unto thy fathers to give thee.
- <sup>12</sup> The LORD shall open unto thee his good treasure, the heaven to give the rain unto thy land in his

season, and to bless all the work of thine hand: and thou shalt lend unto many nations, and thou shalt not borrow.

Healing and deliverance bring joy and glory to God, not sickness and disease. Yeshua came to teach the Torah correctly and He ministered within the Covenants of Israel and the people rejoiced because they were seeing the Covenant promises being fulfilled through Yeshua in their midst and were hearing the Good News of salvation and the Kingdom!

<sup>14</sup> And Jesus returned in the power of the Spirit into Galilee: and there went out a fame of him through all the region round about.

<sup>15</sup> And he taught in their synagogues, being glorified of all.

<sup>16</sup> And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, **as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the sabbath day, and stood up for to read.** 

<sup>17</sup> And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Esaias. The living Torah, full of the Ruach HaKodesh came to minister healing and deliverance and He is still doing it today! Don't swallow that lie that ha satan has told believer's in Messiah over the years, that miracles and healing have been done away with, because he is a liar! God's covenant of healing is still active, because His Covenants are still active. People need to know that God loves them and wants them well just as much today as they did when Yeshua walked in Israel! Because the Body of Messiah has lost sight of their Hebraice/Jewish Roots in Messiah, they have lost sight of His Covenant promises also. Healing is in the Covenants, study the scriptures and renew your thinking to believe the Torah/Word of God! Yeshua is the same Yesterday, Today and Forever. God does not change and His promises in His Torah/Word are everlasting!

This ministry of healing operated through the apostles and is still operating in the Congregation of Messiah today and God wants to use you also to bring healing and deliverance in THE NAME OF YESHUA!

- <sup>14</sup> Afterward he appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they believed not them which had seen him after he was risen.

Because of unbelief and hardness of the heart they could not receive healing, spiritually or physically from Messiah. Those who have faith in Yeshua/Jesus, have been given eyes to see and ears to hear what the Ruach HaKodesh is telling us in His Word-Healing belongs to us and Adonai wants us Whole-spirit, soul and body.

A Roman Centurian, who was a believer in the God of Israel, knew that Yeshua only had to speak and his servant would be healed. He had faith in the Living Torah/Word and because of his faith, his servant was healed. Again, Faith in the Living Torah/Word brought healing to his mans household.

- 5 And when Jesus was entered into Capernaum, there came unto him a centurion, beseeching him,6 And saying, Lord, my servant lieth at home sick of the palsy, grievously tormented.
- <sup>7</sup> And Jesus saith unto him, I will come and heal him.
- <sup>8</sup> The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.
- **9** For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this *man*, Go, and he goeth; and to another, Come, and he cometh; and to my servant, Do this, and he doeth *it*.

The word "Virtue" is really the word Greek word "dunamis" which is translated "power", explosive power, it is the same word for "Dynomite". The crowd sought to touch Him, they were reaching out to the Living Torah from whom all healing power flows. Faith in the Messiah, put a demand on the power within Him, the healing power of the Ruach Ha Kodesh/The Holy Spirit and they were healed!

Also note, He healed them ALL! He didn't say to some, maybe it is not God's will to heal you today, no He healed them because it was God's will for them to be healed based on the Covenants of Israel! Not one person left not receiving what they came for.

17 And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and **a** great multitude of people out of all Judaea and

Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

- 18 And they that were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed.
- 19 And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed *them* all.

Luke 6:17-19 (KJV)

10 lepers were cleansed from lepracy, but the one who came back and gave thanks was made WHOLE. In other words, whatever parts of his body that had decayed and rotted away were totally restored! The others were cleansed and free from the disease, but the one who gave glory to God was made totally whole again!

- <sup>11</sup> And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee.
- <sup>12</sup> And as he entered into a certain village, **there** met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off:

One of the lepers was a Samaritan, who was considered a stranger and an outcast in Israel. Nine kept on walking, but the Samaritan turned around and ran back to the feet of Yeshua, taking hold of Him and praised God for his deliverance in a loud voice and was made WHOLE!

**49** When they which were about him saw what would follow, they said unto him, Lord, shall we smite with the sword?

**50** And one of them smote the servant of the high priest, and cut off his right ear.

51 And Jesus answered and said, Suffer ye thus far. **And he touched his ear, and healed him.** 

52 Then Jesus said unto the chief priests, and captains of the temple, and the elders, which were come to him, Be ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and stayes?

53 When I was daily with you in the temple, ye stretched forth no hands against me: but this is your hour, and the power of darkness. Luke 22:49-53 (KJV)

Even as they were arresting Him, he still brought healing to those who were sending Him to his death. They were only able to take Yeshua/Jesus because God allowed the power of darkness to have its way, only because it was in God's plan, for Yeshua to be the susbsitute for our sins, behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world, and all that sin brings -spiritual death, sickness, disease, emotional problems, whatever the results of sin are in our lives (Deut 28: 14ff), Yeshua came to take it away.

The same healing power that Yeshua walked in, resides in us as His talmidim/disciples, we have been given The Name(Ha Shem) of Yeshua, at The Name(Ha Shem) every sickness and disease has to leave, if we have faith in The Name (Ha Shem).

Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour.2 And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple;

- 3 Who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms.
- 4 And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us.
- 5 And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive something of them.
