**7. We are Blessed.....Deuteronomy 28: 1-14, Galatians 3:9**

**Blessings for Obedience**

**Deu 28:1** “Now if you listen obediently to the voice of Adonai your God, taking care to do all His mitzvot that I am commanding you today, Adonai your God will set you on high—above all the nations of the earth.

Deu 28:2 Then all these blessings will come upon you and overtake you, if you listen to the voice of Adonai your God:

Deu 28:3 “Blessed will you be in the city, and blessed will you be in the field.

Deu 28:4 “Blessed will be the fruit of your womb, the produce of your soil, and the offspring of your livestock—the increase of your herds and the young of your flock.

Deu 28:5 Blessed will be your basket and your kneading bowl.

Deu 28:6 “Blessed will you be when you come in, and blessed will you be when you go out.

Deu 28:7 Adonai will cause your enemies who rise up against you to be struck down before you. They will come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

Deu 28:8 Adonai will command the blessing on you in your barns and in every undertaking of your hand, and He will bless you in the land Adonai your God is giving you.

Deu 28:9 Adonai will establish you as a holy people for Himself, just as He swore to you—if you keep the mitzvot of Adonai your God and walk in His ways.

Deu 28:10 Then all the peoples of the earth will see that you are called by the name of Adonai and they will stand in awe of you.

Deu 28:11 Adonai will make you overflow in prosperity—in the fruit of your womb, the offspring of your livestock and the produce of your soil—on the land Adonai swore to your fathers to give you.

Deu 28:12 Adonai will open for you His good storehouse—the heavens—to give rain for your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand. You will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow.

Deu 28:13 Adonai will make you the head and not the tail, and you will be only above and not below—if you listen to the mitzvot of Adonai your God that I am commanding you today, careful to do them,

Deu 28:14 and do not turn aside from any of the words I am commanding you today, to the right or the left, to go after other gods in order to serve them.

Gal 3:6 Just as Abraham “believed God, and it was credited to him as righteousness,”

Gal 3:7 know then that those who have faith are children of Abraham.

Gal 3:8 The Scriptures, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, proclaimed the Good News to Abraham in advance, saying, “All the nations shall be blessed through you.”

**Gal 3:9 So then, the faithful are blessed along with Abraham, the faithful one.**

Gal 3:11 It is clear that no one is set right before God by Torah, for “the righteous shall live by emunah.” (faith)

*What Paul is saying above is that we are not justified by works of Torah alone, but by faith in the Messiah Yeshua, The Living Torah of YHVH.*

**And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God,....** In his law, and by his prophets:

**to observe *and* to do all his commandments, which I command thee this day;** for without observing them to do them, hearing them would be to little purpose, and they were all of them to be observed and done, the lesser and weightier matters of the law as they were commanded by Moses in the name of the Lord, and as they would be taught, explained, and enforced by the prophets:

**that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the earth:** as they were in the times of David and Solomon.

Exo 15:26 He said, "If you diligently listen to the voice of Adonai your God, do what is right in His eyes, pay attention to His mitzvot, and keep all His decrees, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians. For I am Adonai who heals you."

**Deu 30:15** "See, I have set before you today life and good, and death and evil.

Deu 30:16 What I am commanding you today is to love Adonai your God, to walk in His ways, and to keep His mitzvot, statutes and ordinances. Then you will live and multiply, and Adonai your God will bless you in the land you are going in to possess.

Deu 7:11 Therefore you are to keep the commandment—both the statutes and the ordinances—that I am commanding you today, to do them.

Deu 7:12 “Then it will happen, as a result of your listening to these ordinances, when you keep and do them, that Adonai your God will keep with you the covenant kindness that He swore to your fathers.

**Deu 7:13** He will love you, bless you and multiply you. He will also bless the fruit of your womb and the produce of your soil, your grain and your new wine and your oil, the increase of your herds and the young of your flock, in the land that He swore to your fathers to give you.

Deu 7:14 From all peoples, you will be blessed—there will not be male or female barren among you or your livestock.

Deu 7:15 Adonai will remove all sickness from you, and He will not inflict on you any of the terrible diseases of Egypt that you knew, but will inflict them on all who hate you.

Deu 11:13 Now if you listen obediently to My mitzvot that I am commanding you today—to love Adonai your God and to serve Him with all your heart and soul—

Deu 11:14 then I will give rain for your land in its season—the early rain and the late rain—so that you may gather in your grain, new wine and olive oil.

Deu 11:15 I will give grass in your field for your livestock, and you will eat and be satisfied.

Deu 11:16 Watch yourselves, so your heart is not deceived, and you turn aside and serve other gods and worship them.

Deu 11:17 Then the anger of Adonai will be kindled against you, so He will shut up the sky so that there will be no rain and the soil will not yield its produce. Then you will perish quickly from the good land Adonai is giving you.

Deu 15:5 If only you would carefully listen to the voice of Adonai your God, being careful to do all these mitzvah that I am commanding you today!

Deu 15:6 For Adonai your God will bless you as He promised you. So you will lend to many nations, but not borrow; you will rule over many nations, but they will not rule over you.

Psa 106:3 Blessed are those who maintain justice, who do what is right at all times.

**Psa 119:1** Blessed are those whose way is blameless, who walk in the Torah of Adonai.

Psa 119:2 Happy are those who keep His testimonies, who seek Him with a whole heart,

Psa 119:3 who also do no injustice, but walk in His ways.

Psa 119:4 You have commanded that Your precepts be kept diligently.

Isa 1:18 “Come now, let us reason together,” says Adonai. “Though your sins be like scarlet, they will be as white as snow. Though they be red like crimson, they will become like wool.

Isa 1:19 If you are willing and obey, you will eat the good of the land.

Isa 1:20 But if you refuse and rebel, you will be devoured with the sword.” For the mouth of

Adonai has spoken.

**Isa 55:1** “Ho, everyone who thirsts, come to the water, and you who have no money, come, buy and eat. Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost!

Isa 55:2 Why do you spend money for what is not bread? Your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen diligently to Me, and eat what is good, and delight yourself in abundance.

Isa 55:3 Incline your ear and come to Me. Listen, so that your soul may live. I will make an everlasting covenant with you, the trustworthy loyalty to David.

**8. You Will Be The head and not the tail..... Deuteronomy 28:13** (This applies to those who walk in obedience to God’s teachings and instructions/Torah, in Messiah Yeshua)

*Deu 28:13 And YHVH shall make thee the head, and not the tail; and thou shalt be above only, and thou shalt not be beneath; if that thou hearken unto the commandments of YHVH thy ELOHIM, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them:*

**Head not Tail, Above not Beneath**

**And the Lord shall make thee the head, and not the tail,....** Give them dominion over others, and not make them subject to them; the head signifies rulers and governors, and the tail the common people that are subjects; or the one such that are honorable and in high esteem, and the other such that are mean and base; see Isa 9:14; the Targum of Jonathan is, "the Word of the Lord shall make thee."
