## **Day 2 In Whom I Trust**

### **He Will Not Forsake His Saints**

**Psa 37:1** Of David. Do not fret because of evildoers, nor be envious of them who do wrong.

**Psa 37:2** For like the grass they soon wither and fade like a green herb.

**Psa 37:3 Trust in Adonai and do good. Dwell in the land, feed on faithfulness.**

**Psa 37:4 Delight yourself in Adonai, and He will give you the requests of your heart.**

**Psa 37:5 Commit your way to Adonai. Trust in Him, and He will do it.**

**Psa 37:6** He will bring out your vindication as light, and your cause will shine as noonday.

**Psa 37:7** Be still before Adonai and wait patiently for Him. Do not fret over one prospering in his way, over one carrying out wicked schemes.

**Psa 37:8** Put away anger and turn from wrath. Do not fret—it only leads to doing evil.

**Psa 37:9** For evildoers will be cut off, but those who wait for Adonai—they will inherit the land.

**Psa 37:10 Yet a little while, and the wicked will be no more. Yes, you will look at his place, but he will not be there.**

**Psa 37:11 But the meek will inherit the land, and delight in abundant shalom.**

**Psa 37:12** The wicked plots against the righteous and gnashes at him with his teeth.

**Psa 37:13** The Lord laughs at him—for He sees his day is coming.

Psa 37:14 The wicked have unsheathed their sword and have bent their bow to bring down the poor and needy, to slay those whose conduct is upright.

Psa 37:15 Their sword will pierce their own hearts, and their bows will be broken.

Psa 37:16 Better a little that the righteous have than the wealth of many wicked.

Psa 37:17 For the arms of the wicked will be broken, while Adonai upholds the righteous.

**Psa 37:18 Adonai knows the days of the blameless—their inheritance endures forever.**

**Psa 37:19 They will not be ashamed in an evil time and in days of famine they will be satisfied.**

Psa 37:20 For the wicked will perish, and the enemies of Adonai will be like the beauty of the fields—they will vanish—vanish like smoke.

Psa 37:21 The wicked borrows and does not repay, but the righteous is a gracious giver.

Psa 37:22 For His blessed ones inherit the land. But those He curses will be cut off.

**Psa 37:23 From Adonai a man's steps are made firm, when He delights in his way.**

Psa 37:24 Though he stumble, he will not fall headlong, for Adonai is holding his hand.

**Psa 37:25 I was young and now I am old, yet I have never seen the righteous one forsaken, nor his children begging for bread.**

Psa 37:26 All day long he is gracious and lends. So his offspring will be a blessing.

Psa 37:27 Turn from evil and do good, so you may live forever.

**Psa 37:28 For Adonai loves justice and does not abandon His godly ones. They will be preserved forever, but the seed of the wicked will be cut off.**

**Psa 37:29 The righteous will inherit the land and dwell in it forever.**

**Psa 37:30 The mouth of the righteous utters wisdom and his tongue speaks justice.**

**Psa 37:31 The Torah of his God is in his heart. His steps do not slip.**

Psa 37:32 The wicked lies in wait for the righteous, seeking to slay him.

Psa 37:33 But Adonai will not leave him in his hand, or let him be condemned when judged.

**Psa 37:34 Wait for Adonai and keep His way, and He will exalt you to inherit the land. When the wicked are cut off, you will see it.**

Psa 37:35 I have seen a wicked, ruthless man flourishing like a leafy tree in native soil.

Psa 37:36 But once he passed by, he was no more. Though I looked for him, he could not be found.

Psa 37:37 Notice the man of integrity and watch the upright—for the man of shalom has a future.

Psa 37:38 But transgressors will be destroyed altogether. The future of the wicked will be cut off.

**Psa 37:39 Yet the salvation of the righteous is from Adonai. He is their stronghold in time of trouble.**

Psa 37:40 Adonai helps them and delivers them. He rescues them from the wicked and saves them—because they take refuge in Him. TLV
