

Psa 91:3 For He will rescue you from the hunter's trap and from the deadly pestilence. TLV

## Day 3 Supernatural Deliverance

Exo 6:5 Furthermore, **I have heard the groaning of Bnei-Yisrael**, whom the Egyptians are keeping in bondage. So **I have remembered** My covenant.

Exo 6:6 Therefore say to Bnei-Yisrael: **I am Adonai**, and **I will bring you out** from under the burdens of the Egyptians. **I will deliver you** from their bondage, and **I will redeem you** with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.

Exo 6:7 **I will take you to Myself** as a people, and **I will be your God**. You will know that **I am Adonai your God**, who brought you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians.

Exo 6:8 So I will bring you into the land that I swore to give to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob, and give it to you as an inheritance. I am Adonai."

There are 12 "I's" in these verses. God HIMSELF is the one who will deliver us out of the hands of the evil one, i.e. Egypt.

Exo 12:13 'The blood shall be a sign for you on the houses where you live; and when I see the blood I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy *you* when I strike the land of Egypt.

Heb 9:11 But when Messiah appeared as Kohen Gadol of the good things that have now come, passing through the greater and more perfect Tent not made with hands (that is to say not of this creation),

**Heb 9:12** He entered into the Holies once for all—not by the blood of goats and calves but by His own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

Heb 9:13 For if the blood of goats and bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkling those who have been defiled sanctify for the cleansing of the flesh,

Heb 9:14 **how much more will the blood of Messiah**—who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without blemish to God—cleanse our conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

There are 3 reasons for plagues to come in the Bible

## #1. When Israel was disobedient to Torah, or in rebellion to God's Leadership He sent a plague as judgment to bring them to repentance

Num 11:33 While the meat was still between their teeth, before it was chewed, the anger of the LORD was kindled against the people, and the LORD struck the people with a very severe plague.

Num 14:37 even those men who brought out the very bad report of the land died by a plague before the LORD.

Num\_16:46 Moses said to Aaron, "Take your censer and put in it fire from the altar, and lay incense *on it*; then bring it quickly to the congregation and make atonement for them, for wrath has gone forth from the LORD, the plague has begun!"

Num 16:47 Then Aaron took *it* as Moses had spoken, and ran into the midst of the assembly, for behold, the plague had begun among the people. So he put *on* the incense and made atonement for the people.

Num 16:48 He took his stand between the dead and the living, so that the plague was checked.

Num 16:49 But those who died by the plague were 14,700, besides those who died on account of Korah.

<u>Num\_16:50</u> Then Aaron returned to Moses at the doorway of the tent of meeting, for the plague had been checked.

Num 25:6 Then behold, a man from Bnei-Yisrael came and brought a Midianite woman to his brothers before the eyes of Moses and of the whole assembly of Bnei-Yisrael, while they were weeping at the entrance to the Tent of Meeting!

**Num 25:7** When Phinehas son of Eleazar son of Aaron the kohen saw it, he arose from the midst of the assembly, took a spear in his hand,

Num 25:8 and went after the man of Israel into the tent and pierced them through—both the Israelite man and the woman's belly. Then the plague among Bnei-Yisrael was stopped.

Num 25:9 However, 24,000 were dead because of the plague!

2Ch 6:24 "If Your people Israel are defeated before an enemy because they have sinned against You, yet when they return and confess Your Name, praying and making supplication before You in this House,

2Ch 6:25 then hear from heaven, forgive the sin of Your people Israel and bring them back to the land which You gave to them and to their fathers.

2Ch 6:26 "When the heavens are shut up and there is no rain because they have sinned against You, if they pray toward this place and confess Your Name, turning from their sin because You afflicted them,

2Ch 6:27 then may You hear from heaven and forgive the sin of Your servants, Your people Israel. Indeed may You teach them the good way in which they should walk. Send rain upon Your land that You have given to Your people for an inheritance.

2Ch 6:28 "When there is famine in the land, when there is pestilence, blight, mildew, locust or

grasshopper, when their enemies besiege them in the land by their gates, whatever plague or sickness may come,

2Ch 6:29 and any prayer or plea is offered by any individual or by all Your people Israel—each acknowledging his own afflictions and pain, even spreading his hands toward this House—

2Ch 6:30 then may You hear from heaven, Your dwelling place and forgive. May You give to every man according to all his ways, as You know his heart—for You alone know the hearts of the children of men—

2Ch 6:31 so that they will fear You and walk in Your ways all the days that they live in the land that You gave to our fathers

## #2. On the Nations for how they treat Israel

i.e. The 10 Plagues upon Egypt in Exodus Chapters 7-11

Zec\_14:12 Now this will be the plague with which the LORD will strike all the peoples who have gone to war against Jerusalem; their flesh will rot while they stand on their feet, and their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongue will rot in their mouth.

<u>Zec\_14:15</u> So also like this <u>plague</u> will be the <u>plague</u> on the horse, the mule, the camel, the donkey and all the cattle that will be in those camps.

**Isa 34:1** Draw near, O nations, to hear, and listen, O peoples! Let the earth hear, and all it contains, the world, and all its offspring!

Isa 34:2 For Adonai is enraged at all the nations, and furious at all their armies. He will utterly destroy them. He will give them over to slaughter.

Isa 34:3 So their slain will be thrown out, and the stench of their corpses will rise, and the hills will be drenched with their blood.

Isa 34:4 Then all the host of heaven will dissolve, and the skies will be rolled up like a scroll—so all their array will wither away, like a leaf drooping from a vine, like a fig shriveling from a fig tree.

Isa 34:5 For My sword has drunk its fill in the heavens. See, it will come down upon Edom, upon the people I have devoted to judgment.

Isa 34:8 For Adonai has a day of vengeance, a year of recompense for the hostility against Zion.

## #3 For those who are in rebellion against YHVH and His Mashiach Yeshua

Zec 14:18 If the family of Egypt does not go up or enter, then no *rain will fall* on them; it will be the plague with which the LORD smites the nations who do not go up to celebrate the Feast of Booths.

Rev\_11:6 These have the power to shut up the sky, so that rain will not fall during the days of their prophesying; and they have power over the waters to turn them into blood, and to strike the earth with every plague, as often as they desire.

Rev 16:21 And huge hailstones, about one hundred pounds each, \*came down from heaven upon men; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail, because its plague \*was extremely severe.

However, those who walk in the fear of YHWH and are In Messiah Yeshua, who have not compromised with the World and do not love their lives more then they love Messiah, God will protect from the pestilence/plagues. God differentiates between the righteous and the wicked.

<u>Pro\_11:10</u> When it goes well with the righteous, the city rejoices, And when the wicked perish, there is joyful shouting.

<u>Pro\_11:31</u> **If the righteous will be rewarded in the earth**, How much more the wicked and the sinner!

<u>Pro 12:7</u> The wicked are overthrown and are no more, **But the house of the righteous will stand**.

<u>Pro\_24:16</u> For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again, But the wicked stumble in *time of* calamity

\_Eze\_\_18:20 "The person who sins will die. The son will not bear the punishment for the father's iniquity, nor will the father bear the punishment for the son's iniquity; the righteousness of the righteous will be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked will be upon himself.

Eze\_18:24 "But when a righteous man turns away from his righteousness, commits iniquity and does according to all the abominations that a wicked man does, will he live? All his righteous deeds which he has done will not be remembered for his treachery which he has committed and his sin which he has committed; for them he will die.

<u>Mal 3:18</u> So you will again **distinguish between the righteous and the wicked**, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.

Mat 13:49 "So it will be at the end of the age; the angels will come forth and take out the wicked from among the righteous,
