“Amen!  
Halleluyah!

<sup>5</sup>And a voice went out from the throne, saying,

“Praise our God, all you his servants,  
you who fear him, small and great!”

<sup>6</sup>Then I heard what sounded like the roar of a huge crowd, like the sound of rushing waters, like loud peals of thunder, saying,

“Halleluyah!  
**Adonai, God of heaven’s armies, has begun his reign!**

<sup>7</sup> “Let us rejoice and be glad!  
Let us give him the glory!  
For the time has come for the  
wedding of the Lamb,  
and his Bride has prepared herself—  
<sup>8</sup> fine linen, bright and clean  
has been given her to wear.”

(“Fine linen” means the righteous deeds of God’s people.)

<sup>9</sup>And the angel said to me, “Write: ‘How blessed are those who have been invited to the wedding feast of the Lamb!’ ” Then he added, “These are God’s very words.” <sup>10</sup>I fell at his feet to worship him; but he said, “Don’t do that! I’m only a fellow-servant with you and your brothers who have the testimony of Yeshua. Worship God! For the testimony of Yeshua is the Spirit of prophecy.”

<sup>11</sup>Then I saw heaven opened, and there before me was a white horse. Sitting on it was the one called Faithful and True, and it is in righteousness that he passes judgment and goes to battle. <sup>12</sup>His eyes were like a fiery flame, and on his head were many royal crowns. And he had a name written which no one knew but himself. <sup>13</sup>He was wearing a robe that had been soaked in blood, and the name by which he is called is, “THE WORD OF GOD”. <sup>14</sup>The armies of heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and pure, were following him on white horses. <sup>15</sup>And out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down nations—**“He will rule them with a staff of iron.”** It is he who treads the winepress from which flows the wine of the furious rage of Adonai, God of heaven’s armies. <sup>16</sup>And on his robe and on his thigh he has a name written: “KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS”.<sup>[2]</sup>

that is, the word about trust which we proclaim, namely, <sup>9</sup> that if you acknowledge publicly with your mouth that Yeshua is Lord and trust in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be delivered. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one goes on trusting and thus continues toward righteousness, while with the mouth one keeps on making public acknowledgement and thus continues toward deliverance. <sup>11</sup> For the passage quoted says that everyone who rests **his trust** on him **will not be humiliated**. <sup>12</sup> That means that there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—Adonai is the same for everyone, rich toward everyone who calls on him, <sup>13</sup> since **everyone who calls on the name of Adonai will be delivered**.

<sup>14</sup> But how can they call on someone if they haven’t trusted in him? And how can they trust in someone if they haven’t heard about him? And how can they hear about someone if no one is proclaiming him? <sup>15</sup> And how can people proclaim him unless God sends them?—as the Tanakh puts it,

**How beautiful are the feet of those announcing good news about good things!”[2]**
