13 Modules of Study In This Book to Complete

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Module Overview of Studies

MODULE 1 - THE ROAD TO REDEMPTION

Why is this the most important verse? Because it establishes that God is the creator of the Universe and all that it contains and He is the creator of mankind. If you do not believe this verse, then you will not be able to understand anything else. From the very beginning God has paved the Road to Redemption and has given us the road map called The Bible to explain how to get to our final destination.

MODULE 2 - WHAT DOES IT MEANS TO BE MESSIANIC

What Does it mean to be a part of a Messiah-centered community born out of the Judaic Roots revival restoring the entire commonwealth of Israel. In order to be a light for Yeshua/Jesus in the community, we endeavor to create a contextually Messianic Jewish atmosphere where all believers can follow Yeshua/Jesus as a unified Commonwealth of Israel; where both Jewish Believers and Non Jewish Believers may reconnect with the Hebrew Roots of their faith. Together, this reconciled Messianic community can witness to GOD/YHWH's faithfulness toward the people of Israel and toward the nation.

MODULE 3 - WHO WE ARE IN MESSIAH

Knowing Who you are in Messiah Yeshua and what He has done for you is vitally important to your Messianic walk in Him. This study will firmly implant you in the knowledge who you are in Messiah Yeshua as His Talmidim/Disciple.

MODULE 4 - HEALING OUR COVENANT OF BLESSING

The promises of healing is found in the Tenach and in the Brit HaDasha Yeshua confirms that it was Gods will that His people be made whole and He healed them! God is the same, yesterday, today and forever, He never changes and His will never changes because His will is His Word from B'reshet to Revelation.

It is important that you study these verses in context, but you will see as we study what the Word says about healing and that Yahweh is our healer. Health and restoration are always associated with God's blessings. Sickness and disease is not Yahweh's will for us health and restoration brings glory to God. Yeshua said that ha satan comes to steal, kill and destroy but He came that we may have life more abundantly.

MODULE 5 - HOLINESS AND PURITY

As believers, we have been called to be set apart. This is what holiness is about and that is what Torah is about, to be set apart as a light shining in darkness.

We are not our own, we were bought and paid for by the blood of Yeshua. This booklet is to help you learn what the walk of holiness looks like.

Our Heavenly Father is a Holy God and we are called to be a holy/Kadosh set apart peculiar people. Holy in Hebrew is Qadash or Kadosh. Qadash is a great word on sanctification and majestic cleanliness, it means.

MODULE 6 - OVERVIEW OF THE FEASTS

The Bible calls the Biblical Feasts "My Feasts", in other words they are Feasts that Honor YHWH and are for all of His people Israel - Judah, Ephraim and the Nations Grafted Into the Olive Tree (Romans 11). They are a prophetic picture of the Mashiach Yeshua Ben Yosef (His first coming) and Mashiach Yeshua Ben David (His return). They are Holy Convocations for His people Israel and the Redeemed, which includes the Shabbat, which is the First Set apart time mentioned in Leviticus 23.

MODULE 7 - SHABBAT RESTING IN MESSIAH

“Shabbot is meaningful to both Jews and Christians. A Jewish tradition states that when all Israel-as a nation- keeps the Sabbath, The Messiah will come. Whether or not the Rabbis who postulated the position literally believed it, it demonstrates how important they deemed Shabbot to be” Barry & Steffi Rubin

Of course, we know Messiah has come, and He will return again to set up His Kingdom, in the meantime He has left us with the gift of Shabbat as we enter into His rest and await His return to earth.

MODULE 8- THE FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT/RUACH

Avinu/Our Heavenly Father wants us to develop the fruit of the Ruach HaKodesh/Holy Spirit that He has implanted in our spirits. Yeshua said that we would be known by our fruit, what kind of fruit have you been growing? We need to cultivate the Fruit of the Spirit in our lives so that Yeshua/Jesus would be glorified and that others would want to become Talmidim of Yeshua Ha Mashiach/Jesus the Messiah as well.

MODULE 9- THE MITZVOT AND BLESSING OF TITHING

Yes, you can do a Google search and find articles both pro and con from Jewish and Christian sources regarding tithing. However, the bottom line is, tithing was given by God to make sure that His Word would go forth throughout the earth and that takes money.

I really believe our attitude towards money is a direct reflection on our attitude towards God.

Why, if we truly want to serve Him and reach people, feed the poor, clothe the naked, teach and train Talmidim/Disciples for the Kingdom are we fighting over whether we should financially support these endeavors?

MODULE 10 - THE POWER OF PRAYER

The Torah teaches that we should pray during times of trouble but also daily not just when there is trouble. Are we living in troubled times? YES!!! Then we better get on our face before Hashem and pray as our forefathers did before us.

We need the Fire of YHWH restored to our hearts. We as YHWH's people need to repent of our carnal ways and start putting YHWH first and spend time in daily prayer and the Word.

The Psalms are the Jewish prayer book. He is calling His people back to the ways of Torah and prayer is the heart of His Torah.

We need to ask YHWH to stir our Hearts by the Ruach HaKodesh

MODULE 11 - THE WORLD TO COME/OLAM HABA

The creation of man testifies to the eternal life of the soul. The Torah says, "And the Almighty formed the man of dust from the ground, and He blew into his nostrils the SOUL of life" (Genesis 2:7). On this verse, the Zohar states that "one who blows, blows from within himself," indicating that the soul is actually part of God's essence. Since God's essence is completely spiritual and non-physical, it is impossible that the soul should die. (The commentator Chizkuni says this why the verse calls it "soul of LIFE.")

That's what King Solomon meant when he wrote, "The dust will return to the ground as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it." (Ecclesiastes 12:17)

MODULE 12 - THE IMPORTANCE OF BIBLE STUDY

God's Word has been unscrolled in both the Scriptures and in His incarnate Son – Yeshua Ha Mashiach/Jesus The Messiah/Christ. Yeshua/Jesus, in describing the importance of the eternal Scriptures said, "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God" (Matt 4:4) He also commended the steadfast inquiry into the Word of God. "Search the Scriptures...they...testify of Me." (John 5:39). There is no such thing as health or growth in Christian living apart from a clear priority on the place of the Bible in the life of the individual or the group. The Scriptures are the conclusive standard for our faith, morals, and practical living and are the nourishment for our rising to strength in faith, holiness in living, and effectiveness in service. The Holy Spirit who comes to fill us is the same Person who has given us the Book to guide and sustain us. Jack W. Hayford

MODULE 13 - THE IMPORTANCE OF COMMUNITY

The Internet Is Not a Congregation or a Community. We need to be connected to a local assembly of Messianic, God Fearing, Word Teaching, Faith Walking people with Strong accountable leadership!

People may worship and participate in the activities of the Congregation but a clear distinction occurs in their attitude once they make a statement of commitment to membership.

Congregational Membership is not the formulation of a roster, but a calling forth of the commitment of covenantal integrity.

One aspect of covenantal relationships is that the parties involved make an effort to communicate and define what their relationship is.

What then does membership in a Congregation mean?
